On Monday, August 24, 2020, Aaron Ramon Brooks, loving husband, son, brother, uncle and father of two, passed away at the age of 47. Aaron was born September 17, 1972 in Washington, D.C. to William and Josephine Brooks. Aaron was educated in the D.C. and PG County Public Schools systems. He graduated from Potomac High School. He served in the U.S. Marine Corps where he met his wife and received his Accounting degree from the University of Maryland University College. Aaron worked as an accounting professional and as a well known disk jockey for WPGC 95.5 maintaining both careers for over 20 years in the DMV and abroad. Aaron enjoyed life, he loved to cook and took great pride in raising his two children Brianna and Aaron. Aaron married Kennie Williamson on July 8, 2017 and spent his last few years in Ruskin, Florida.

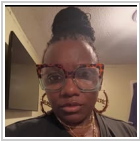

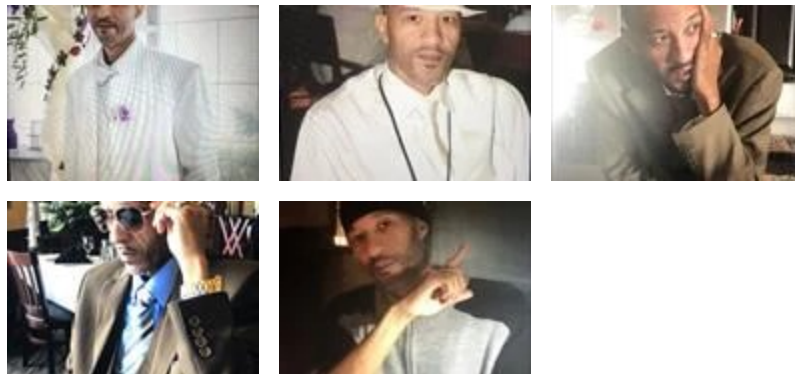

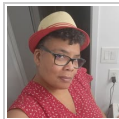
