In their sophomore year at Maryland, Marshall joined the Navy and they married. Adrienne spent time in California as a Navy wife and eventually caring for their newborn son Michael Maurice Brown. They eventually came back to Maryland making it their permanent home. At which point, Adrienne went to work for the Post Office. Adrienne was a loyal member of The Order of the Eastern Star. She was a voracious reader and spent a great deal of her youth with her head buried in Nancy Drew mysteries. She loved watching tennis and enjoyed a good card game as well.

In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her brothers, Rodney Avery Kemp and Donald Alan Kemp. She is survived by her son Michael M.
