### The Life of Ann Putney

On Tuesday, January 11, 2022, our beloved Mother, Grandmother, Sister, and Auntie transitioned from this world to eternal peace.

Ann was born on July 7, 1944, in Richmond, VA to Jack and Ella Wilson. She was educated in Nottoway County, VA., graduating from Luther H. Foster in 1962. On December 22, 1963, she accepted Catholicism with baptism receiving her first communion later the same month. In early 1964, she moved to the Washington, D.C. area with her Aunt and there she would meet the love of her life. January 23, 1965, she confirmed her faith and was married at St. Luke Catholic Church to the late Leroy Putney Sr.

Ann dedicated 30 years of her professional life to the FBI retiring in 1994. After retirement, she dedicated her life to her passion; mentoring and teaching the next generation. A dedicated

member of St. Margaret's Catholic Church, she worked in the Daycare Center for 15 years. She served as President of the Catholic Youth Organization committee as well as the coach of the girl's basketball team.

Her home was the hub for the holidays where Family gathered to celebrate; it was filled with many years of love, laughter and joy.

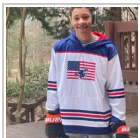
