Anthony C. Biggs, the third child of Claudia Lovinia Biggs and the late William Biggs, fell asleep in death at his home in Washington, DC on Tuesday, December 6, 2022. He was 58 years old. While his family and friends are shocked by his unexpected death, we are so thankful to have had him for those 58 years.

Anthony was born in Washington, DC on March 16, 1964. He was educated in the DC Public School System. He pursued many interests including veterinary care and voice over work. For the past 25 years he worked as an unarmed security officer, finding a great deal of satisfaction in assisting others. He worked most recently for SecTek in Tysons Corner, Virginia.

Anthony was our gentle giant. He will be remembered as a quiet and gentle man who dearly loved his family. As his sister Wendy says "I knew he loved me by the way he smiled at me when he walked into the room. He was so reliable, so dependable."

"Anthony is a good guy, he's pretty cool." That was so true. He had a way of making you feel special and letting you know how much he cared just by the way he spoke to you.

Anthony enjoyed visiting the Smithsonian museums. He collected diecast model cars -- the red convertible was his favorite. He was an avid reader. He would pick a subject and learn as much as he could about it. His favorite thing was learning about and caring for animals. He was fascinated with the beauty of animals and their intelligence. From the time he was a small child, he had a caring hand with them. We remember him taking care of a tiny little puppy that everyone had given up on, including the vet. He patiently nursed him back to health and Skipper grew into a 90 lb. German Shepherd. Kindness and being willing to help were lifelong traits of his. He was a caring, supportive, and loving son, brother, nephew, cousin and friend. Anthony appreciated Bible principles and enjoyed learning about God.

Anthony is preceded in death by his father, William Biggs.
