



## Arlene Altman-Wilson

October 27, 1938 - December 24, 2015

Of Harbour Square, Washington, DC died peacefully at home, December 24, 2015 at age 77. She is survived by her husband, Dr. Reginald Wilson, and a brother, Gerald Small, of Albuquerque, New Mexico. She is also mourned by dozens of relatives in Canada and in Brazil.

She earned a master's degree in Early Childhood Development from Wayne State University (Detroit) and was director of the child care program at the US Senate from 1984 to 1993 before going into private business. She was diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease in 2010 and died of complications from disease. A memorial service will be held January 2, 2016, at Westminster Presbyterian Church at 2 p.m.
