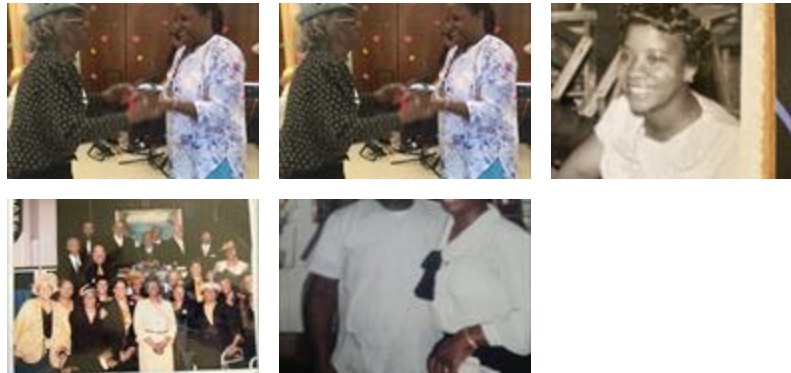
*You fed me well, you made me strong

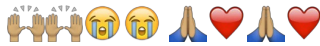
