"Auntie GG."

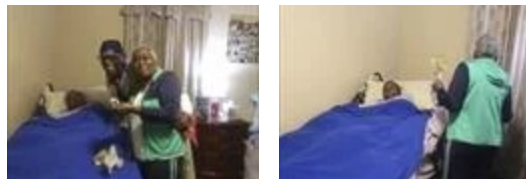

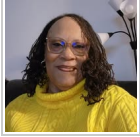
