Clyde graduated from Logan High School in Concord North Carolina. He received his B.A. Degree in Elementary Education from Livingston College in Salisbury, North Carolina. Clyde also received his masters in administration. He was a member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. He played basketball, baseball, and tennis. As a child, he joined Union Baptist Church in Concord, North Carolina and in his later years he attended Mount Jezreel Baptist Church in Silver Spring, MD. He was also an outstanding dedicated teacher in the District of Columbia for over 40 years.

Once he graduated, he married his college sweetheart, Elizabeth Street, and they settled in Forestville Maryland. They were just one-month shy of celebrating 44 years of marriage in July. He was smart, tall. dark and handsome and mesmerized all the little girls in the class. We had never had a male teacher at the school before him and he was Black on top of that

A commodity then. He was so smart and taught with patience and clarity to the smart kids (like me) and to the weakest link so that everyone in his class excelled. I always thought I would become a teacher just like him. (That's until I got older and realized the salary for those in the school system who work so hard.) But his skills and teaching did inspire my career somewhat because I became a CPA before retiring after nearly 40 years. He was truly a beautiful person. When I googled his name I did not expect to read about his funeral. I can relate to the family because I just lost my dad on June 30, 2020. He would have been 97 years old this November. We had a very intimate funeral at St Luke Catholic Church on East Capitol st. Now I feel like I have lost 2 of my idols.

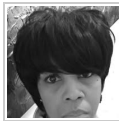

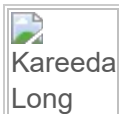
