



MRS DOROTHY MAE FULLER

September 3, 1924 - April 28, 2020

Dorothy Mae Fuller (affectionately know as Mother Fuller) was born on September 3, 1924, in Waterloo South Carolina. She was called to her heavenly home on Tuesday April 28, 2020. Her parents were the late Willie and Lula Williams. She was the fourth of six children and had a fraternal twin brother Dolphus who preceded her in death at the age of 38. At an early age she joined Laurel Hill Baptist Church.

Mother Fuller was married to the late Jesse Ben Fuller and was the mother of six children: Bessie, Jessie,, Robert, Ida, Willie, and Debra. She was educated in the public school system of South Carolina.

After moving to Washington, D.C., she joined Greater Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church. She was a faithful member for 40 years. Mother Fuller was an active member of the Missionary Ministry, Nurse's Ministry, Mother's Board, Golden Aides, Pastor's Aid Ministry and Sunday School.

On September 10, 2000 she joined New Abundant Life Missionary Baptist Church and worshiped with them until she became ill and could no longer attend church. While at NALMBC Mother Fuller served on the Deaconess Ministry, Missionary Ministry and Silver Eagles Ministry. She loved her church, her Pastor Kenneth L. Hilliard and First Lady Vanessa Hilliard. Her favorite scripture was Psalm 34 and favorite hymns were "Jesus Is Real" and "Blessed

Assurance”.

Mother Fuller was employed as a housekeeper. She continued this employment until failing health force her to retire. A few of her favorite things to do was going to church, cooking and being with her family.
