Esther Vernell Fields Moore, daughter of the late Matthew and Cloura Lee Fields, was born on December 2, 1935 in Goldsboro, North Carolina (Wayne County). She was the 2nd oldest of four children.

Esther accepted Jesus Christ as her personal savior at an early age at the Hooks Grove Missionary Baptist Church in Pikeville, North Carolina. In her later years, she united with Cornerstone Baptist Church in Temple Hills, Maryland. She served faithfully for years as a Sunday School Teacher, an Usher and as a Nurse on duty for the church.

Esther completed nursing school and began her career as a registered nurse. She worked at several hospitals in different states before retiring from her job as a psychiatric nurse at Saint Elizabeth's Hospital in Washington, D.C. She retired on March 31, 1989 with 22 years of service.

On December 26, 1959, Esther married Frank Donald Moore and to that union a daughter and son were born, Vanessa and Darryl Moore.
