



Fannie Lavinia Johnson

July 25, 1928 - September 26, 2014

Of Washington, DC passed away peacefully on September 26, 2014. She was the second of seven children born to the late Rev Burnett C. and Marie M. Robinson of Washington, DC. Ms. Johnson was united in holy matrimony to Jacque Johnson, Sr. (divorced). To this union were born two sons, Jacque Johnson Jr. (Valeria) of Charlotte, NC and Jerome Johnson (Victoria, deceased) of Washington, DC. Fannie was a worshipping and lifetime member of Brown Memorial AME Church in Washington, DC and served as President and Vice President of the Brown family Stewardess Board No. 2. Fannie was also a 25 year charter member of the Stewardess Training Board. Fannie retired from the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) in 1986 with 33 years of service, two years' service with the Army at the Pentagon and one year service with the General Accounting office (GAO). Ms. Johnson was preceded in death by three sisters, Arnetta Olivia Robinson, Rosa Marie White and Delores Patricia Robinson and brother, Burnett C. Robinson Jr. She leaves behind two sisters, Conchita Joyce Elliott of Woodbridge, VA and Salada Lynwood Robinson of North Carolina. Fannie expressed a desire to "leave quietly" and to have a private family memorial service. Interment will be at Lincoln Memorial Cemetery in Suitland, MD.
