



Gary Laverne McPherson

May 27, 1951 - March 27, 2021

Deacon Gary L. McPherson was born in Charleston, South Carolina on May 27, 1951 to his proud parents: Jervey and Thomasina McPherson. Gary attended the Mary Ford Elementary School, and graduated from the Bonds-Wilson High School where he played the french horn and was a member of the Marching Cobra's Band.

After high school, Gary attended South Carolina State University where he earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting. Always musically inclined, Gary became a member of the University's Mighty Bulldog Marching Band - and was later accepted into South Carolina's "All-State Marching Band."

After graduation, Gary worked for 25 years as an accountant for the Charleston Naval Shipyard. He also taught accounting at The City College of Chicago for 2 years. Gary later moved to the Washington DC area where he worked as an accountant for Greenpeace USA.

Gary was married to Ms. Felicia Lassiter. He was later remarried and joined union with Mrs. Vivian McPherson. He is blessed with two stepdaughters from this union - Tandy Mazo and Cheri Bailey.

In 1995 Gary met Rev. Ida Moss and the Greater Works Ministry team while they were distributing KFC chicken boxes to the homeless at the MLK Community Center in Arlington VA. Gary rolled up his sleeves and starting helping - and he never stopped. The Greater Works Ministry team later began providing vocational training to at-risk young adults that were aging-out of the

DC Foster Care System. Gary became one of the instructors and began providing training in Bookkeeping skills.

In 2013, when the Greater Works Ministry Team decided to start a Church, Gary became "the great evangelist!" He was always out on the street corners with his tambourine, singing Christian songs, distributing tracks, and inviting people to Bible study. He worked tirelessly toward this endeavor, and was a central figure in helping to plant The Greater Works Christian Church. Gary was truly, "On The Battlefield" for the Lord!

Gary was always a humble, loving, and kind-hearted person, who would overlook any rudeness from his fellow man. He was quick to offer prayer for those who needed it, and was never judgmental.
