“ When I think of my G.G. , all I can say is beautiful, strong, talented, grateful and inspiring.

My mother had me at the tender age of 18. When she left to go to school in Oklahoma my GG. Took full responsibility for me, and I became her baby from that moment on. Before I started school at the age of 6, my GG home schooled me. She taught me to read and write very well. By the time it was time for me to start school, although I didn't go to kindergarten I was well prepared thanks to her. She would color with me and build doll houses out of empty wine boxes. She was very resourceful and would make doll furniture out of anything. She did such a great job at it one would think it was purchased from the store. She used to sit in the floor and play with me. We made doll clothes out of old material from clothes that were too small for me. Everything was made by hand, including the dolls sometimes. My GG was very protective over me to the point that I had to sit in the room with her all day just so that she knew I was safe. All the other kids would be outside playing but I had to wait until she was ready or had time to come sit on the porch and watch me.

As I got older she began to let go just a little. Lol I could sit on the porch by myself and eat popsicles. When I got into trouble she would send me to the tree to get a switch. I always tried to find the most dried out ones I could find so that it would break when she switched my legs. She would go out and get a green juicy one and it was on, you would think I had the Holy Ghost. Even though I thought she was the meanest woman alive at those moments I thank God for them. She put the fear of God in me that I will be eternally grateful for.

My GG taught me The Lord's Prayer and would kneel at the bedside with me every night and say it with me. By the time we were done naming people for God to bless my knees would be sore. I slept with her and she would always wake up to make sure I was covered up. I knew this because I didn't sleep very well because she moved a lot. But once she found her sleeping position you had better not move a muscle to wake her. Lol those were the good old days. GG used to tell me the story of Paminomous who was a forgetful little

boy that got into mischief all the time. She was fun and strict all at the same time. If she liked you, you knew it and it showed. If she “didn’t care for your ways” you knew that too because she would let you know. But she never used the words of hate or dislike for people. She truly loved everybody. I had many friends who would come to visit me but spend most of their time with my GG. Once I was in High School GG became my confidant for little situations that most high schoolers go through. I could literally tell her any and everything without worrying about it getting out or having to be told I told you so. She never threw any issue back up at you once it was solved. My GG was truly the greatest inspiration in my life. I cannot imagine where I would be had it not been for her. She passed down her strength and morals to all who cared to receive it. Life without her will never be the same.

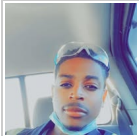

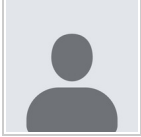
