Harold Major Tucker, the son of the late Henry and Mildred Tucker, was born in Halifax County Virginia on June 11, 1924. He transitioned from this life on November 15, 2016 at 6pm.

He attended public school in Halifax County, Virginia. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1943 to 1946. He was joined in holy matrimony to the late Mattie Sweeney in August of 1946. Of that union seven children were born of whom two have preceded him in death (Willard and Ronnie). In December 1954, they moved from Virginia to Washington DC in search of a better life. He did construction work until he joined the U.S. Postal Service. He retired from the U.S. Postal Service in 1989.

He was a kind and gentle man who loved his family. He helped any and everyone when needed. He was firm in his conviction, unashamed, and unafraid. He let the world know that he was on the Lord's side.

He accepted Christ at an early age and joined the First Baptist Church of Nathalie Virginia. While living in Washington DC, he joined the New Samaritan
