He was drafted into the US Army during the Vietnam War on May 15, 1969, only a month and four days after his 20th birthday. He was honorably discharged on August 29, 1970 and received three medals for his service, including The National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal and The Vietnam Campaign Medal. In 1980, he fell in love with Diane Kidd and produced two daughters: Tanitta Marie and Katrena Lanore Glover. Although he never married, Larry loved his girls and fostered many other children, sons and daughters, alike.

Affectionately called "Hollywood" by friends and family, Larry was the life of the party everywhere he went. No matter where he was, people knew him. He made us all laugh with his strong raspy voice. He was preceded in death by his parents, Willie and Charlie Mary Glover; his older sisters, Margareet Reed and Willa Mary Glover Page, and his brother, John Williams.
