Odie was a dedicated educator who poured into generations of students. She earned her bachelor's degree from Jackson State University and her master's degree from Loyola University Chicago. She was united in holy matrimony to her beloved husband, James Penny, with whom she shared 70 years of love, partnership, and devotion and a friendship of over 85 years.

She was preceded in death by her son, Selwyn Andre Penny, and her beloved sister, Louise Lathan Hall.
