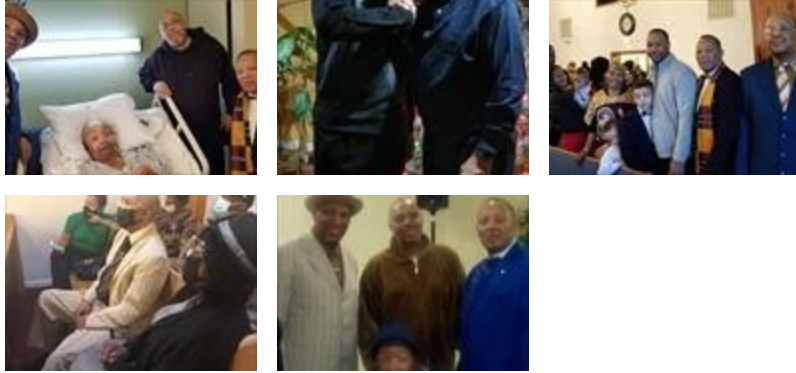
Take your rest, uncle Ray! The memories you left with us are but a million grains of sand that shall sustain us in perpetuity.
