Robert Andrew Cole Jr., slipped quietly into eternal rest on Saturday December 18, 2021, at his home in Clinton, MD. Robert was born on December 28, 1959 in Washington, DC to the late Robert A. Cole, Sr., and Viola M. Cole.

Robert accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Holy Comforter St. Cyprian Catholic Church, located at 1357 E Capitol St. SE, Washington, DC. Robert often visited the family church amongst other churches, he enjoyed the early services.

Robert began his education in the District of Columbia School system; he continued his education in the Prince Georges County School System having graduated from Oxon Hill High School. From there he enlisted into the U.S Navy where he proudly served his country from (1979-1984).

Robert's civilian professional career was in accounting. He worked for the American Bankers Association, the International City/County Management Association Retirement Corporation (ICMA-RC) and prior to his passing the International Brotherhood of Teamsters since June 2014. Robert was an avid sports enthusiast; a die-hard Dallas Cowboys fan! Along with the Washington
