Robert E. Hickman, Jr. was born on December 7, 1957 in Washington, D.C. He earned his heavenly wings on June 11, 2021. Born to the late Robert E. Hickman, Sr. (deceased) and Mamie L. Hickman (deceased), he was the youngest of two other siblings; Patrick Hickman (deceased) and Pamela Hickman (deceased).

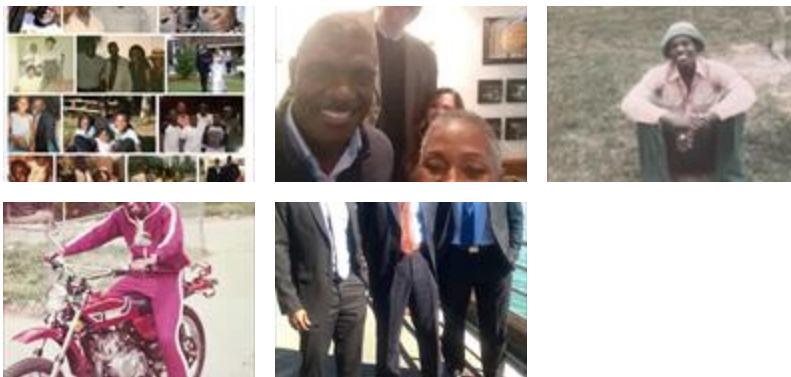

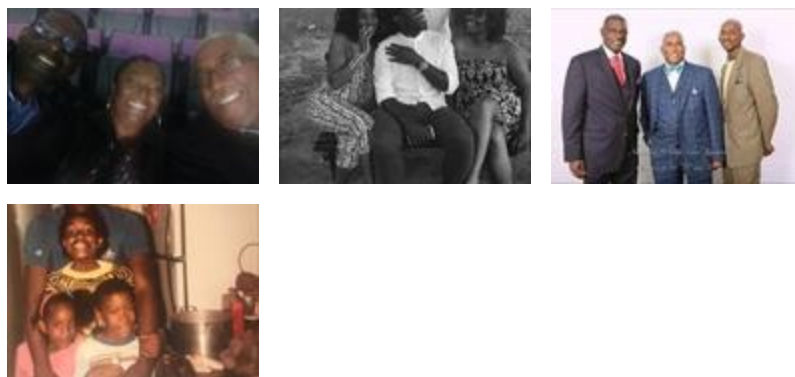
