Ron completed his early education within the D.C. public school system before receiving his Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Maryland. He was a huge fan of the Maryland Terrapins and regularly represented his Alma mater by wearing his favorite baseball cap and other Terrapins gear. Ronald accepted Christ at a young age in his father’s church. His love of the Lord was apparent throughout his life and he took great pleasure in reading his Bible and prayer. After serving two years of active duty in the U.S. Army, Ronald procured employment with The Adjutant General’s Office, U.S. Department of Army. He was then selected for the Management Intern Program which led to a permanent position with the U.S. Department of Transportation. 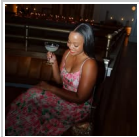
