The Life Story of Ruth Rebecca Culp

Ruth Rebecca Culp's amazing life began January 16, 1950, in LaPlata, MD. Because Ruthie was breach birth, she was the first African American baby born in LaPlata Hospital. She was raised by her loving mother and father, the late Joseph Leroy and Blanche Hill. She was raised in Shiloh, Maryland and then they moved to Washington, DC when she was in grade school. Ruthie was educated in the Washington, DC school system and graduated from Chamberlin Vocational High School in 1968. She continued to work for the U.S. Housing of Urban Development as a Clerk. She had a distinguished career and retired after 25 years from AT&T. Ruthie, as was affectionately called, was the eldest of three girls. Ruthie married Air Force SSgt. John "Kevin" Irvine Culp, May 16, 1972, and moved to Nebraska. In 1974, the couple moved to New Hampshire, where they welcomed their only child, Cherie Michelle Mason. Ruthie returned to Maryland in the 1970's where she enjoyed a full life, filled with loving family and friends. Ruthie departed

peacefully on June 1, 2020.

Ruthie lived a grand life filled with family, close friends, and social events. She had a heart of gold and was a true example of love to everyone she came across. Make no mistake, Ruthie never met a stranger. Ruthie had a host of extended family members, who all loved and adored her. She showered each one with love and affection as if they were her very own.

During the 1970's, Ruthie went to work for AT&T in various Administrative positions. Ruthie's colleagues quickly became lifelong friends, creating many wonderful memories.
