I am so sorry for your great loss. I had the pleasure of meeting and working with Tabitha at Cushman Darby & Cushman after I moved to the Washington, DC area. We were a close knit group of young, black women working in the Wordprocessing Center. Tabitha worked on the day shift and I worked the night shift but we all got to interact before our shifts changed. Tabitha always pleasant, smiling and laughing as she shared stories about her four boys and her Bob. She loved her family dearly. She loved God dearly. As the years went by and we moved onto other law firms, we lost touch personally. But whenever I would speak with our mutual friend, Theresa, I would ask about Tabitha. I remember the tragic loss of her son and how difficult that time was for her and I prayed she would be able to heal her heart. As the years went by, we only saw each other at services of lost coworkers and it was always a good reunion. I knew how hard she had worked, went to school, sold real estate, raised her family, and lived her life to the fullest. Then I heard she and Bob got married a few years ago. I was so happy they had managed to stay together all these years. That's real love. This year, she contacted send me a shoutout on FB for my birthday. 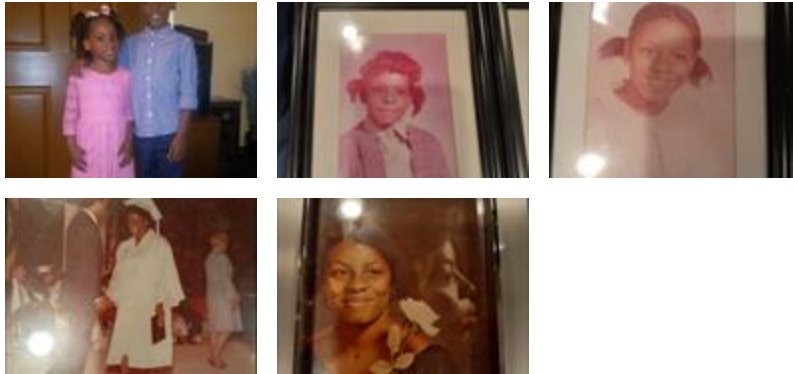

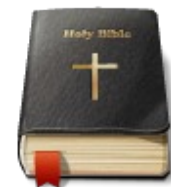
