Tecora Bussie Jimason fell asleep in death on Saturday, November 28, 2020 after a 5-year battle with Cancer. During her final days, Tecora was surrounded by her loving husband and their three children. She was born on June 25, 1941 in Washington, DC to Carey Bussie and Cora Bing; she was the youngest of eight children.

Tecora's early childhood training and education came through the Prince George's Public-School System where she graduated from Fairmont Heights High School. After graduation, she started working for C&P Telephone Company and after seven years of service she wanted to advance professionally, so she enrolled in Cortez Peters Secretarial School in Washington, DC. While attending Cortez Peters, Tecora made rapid advancement and received high scores which got the attention of the federal government. The Federal Trade Commission petitioned Tecora to join them as a research assistant in their personnel department. Tecora then went on to work for the U.S. Census Bureau in Suitland, Maryland where she retired in December 2004.

On June 22, 1963 Tecora married the love of her life, Rufus "Butch" Jimason, Jr. and of that union, they were blessed with three children, David, Cecilia and Cheryl; two grandchildren, Janelle and Nina and one great-granddaughter, Marley. Tecora was an avid reader as a young child which continued into adulthood. You would often find her reading the bible, enjoying a book, reading the newspaper, doing crossword puzzles and in today's tech world, she loved playing games and listening to music on her iPad.

Raised to have a strong faith in God, Tecora always had a solid spiritual foundation. She was initially introduced to Jehovah's Witnesses and their faith at the age of 18 through a dear friend, Sister Mayola "Chicken" Frazier. However, it would be years later in September 1975, when Tecora would dedicate her life to serve Jehovah God by means of baptism. Since then, the focus of her life has been serving Jehovah and the preaching and teaching of the good news of God's Kingdom. She loved sharing the wonderful hope of the future as found in the bible, sharing the 'good news' with family, friends and all those she met. Her loving, gentle manner would draw many to her,

whether it was for a word of advice, a comforting hug or simply an ear to listen. Tecora's warm, loving personality drew many to her. She may have only birthed three children, but she was "Mom" or "Mama J" to many, and sister and friend to many more. One of the greatest joys she would experience while serving Jehovah was to see her children make their dedication and witness her beloved husband dedicate his life as well through water baptism in January 2005.

Tecora is survived by her husband Rufus, children David, Cecilia and Cheryl, her granddaughters Janelle and Nina and great-granddaughter, Marley. She is also survived by her last living sibling, Phillip Bussie along with her extended brothers and sisters Joseph, Reginald "Reggie" (Retta), Nathaniel "Squeeky" (Rita), Jerome "Nutty" (Lynn), JoAnne "Chaing", Burnetta and Sandra "Punkin" along with a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and other dear relatives who loved her so.

She will be dearly missed!
