Tomie Lee is survived by his devoted daughter Celeste Elaine Sullivan and loving brother Wallace Bright Jr.; a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends. He is preceded in death by his beloved wife, Rachel Sullivan and devoted mother, Lillie Mae Bright, and loving father Larry Sullivan.
